Bobby D. Moser became vice president for University Outreach in 2001, having served as chair of the President's Council for Outreach and Engagement and the Outreach and Engagement Steering Committee, forerunners of the Office of University Outreach and Engagement. Moser has developed educational collaborations with Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa and Asia and has received regional and national outstanding college teaching awards. He initiated the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges (NASULGC) task force for Globalizing Agricultural Science and Education Programs for America (GASEPA), was the founding leader of the Agricultural Satellite Program consortium (now American Distance Education Consortium) and served on its board of directors.

As Vice President for Agricultural Administration and dean for the College of Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, Bobby Moser heads the College's academic programs, Ohio State University Extension, the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center and the Agricultural Technical Institute in Wooster. Before becoming Vice President for Agricultural Administration in 1991, Moser served as Director of Ohio State University Extension beginning in 1988. He came to Ohio after seven years at the University of Missouri where he was associate dean of agriculture and agriculture extension program director and chaired the Department of Animal Science. Prior to that, he was a faculty member at the University of Nebraska, a 4-H agent in Kansas and a livestock buyer for an Oklahoman food company. Under his leadership, the College received a W.K. Kellogg grant to realign itself for the 21st century. He chaired the NASULGC Board on Agriculture Budget Committee from 1998 to 1999 and is now chair-elect of the Agriculture Policy Board of Directors.

Bobby Moser was inducted into the International Adult and Continuing Education Hall of Fame (2005) in conjunction with the annual University Continuing Education Association meeting. Moser was recognized for overseeing one of the largest adult continuing education and Extension programs in the nation.
